ERASMUS+ COOPERATION PROJECTS & other EU funding

Presentation

Erasmus+ is the European programme for education, sports and culture. It has facilitated the mobility of over 4 million people in Europe since 2014. Still, the Erasmus+ programme and other EU funding schemes are slightly known by schools, training centres, sport clubs, NGOs and other organisations who are its direct beneficiaries.

During this course we will learn how to apply for an Erasmus+ KA2 Strategic Partnership and we will learn on other funding possibilities. Cooperation with Europe has never been easier!

The **objectives** of the course are:

- To learn about the funding opportunities offered by the Erasmus+, Creative Europe and Europe for Citizens programmes.
- To identify and prepare the most relevant documentation required to apply for these projects.
- To know about the key aspects of the Erasmus+ application form.
- To identify and use different tools to find partners for your project in Europe.

Target group

The training course is addressed to primary and secondary school teachers, VET teachers, VET trainers, adults' teachers, managers and employees of enterprises as well as social and youth workers of non-profit organization and public entities.

Course language

This course can be provided both in English and Spanish.

Methodology

The methodology used in the course consists mostly on practical tasks with the teacher's explanation of specific contents related to the objectives of the course.

Constant feedback from the teacher will ensure that the concepts, tools and methods are acquired by all participants.
