

COURSE TITLE

GAMIFICATION APPLIED TO EDUCATION

Presentation

Playing has always been an excellent way to learn. Games and ludic activities had been part of the teaching-learning process since its very beginning. Gamification takes all these benefits and tries to make the most of them by deconstructing games into their fundamental parts and showing us how to apply them in non-ludic environments such as companies, business enterprises or education.

The **objectives** of the course are:

- To get a good understanding of what Gamification is and where it comes from.
- To identify the different elements of games and learn how to apply them in contexts other than playing.
- To learn the different grades of Gamification and be able to select the one more suitable for their needs.
- To get a good data base of tools and applications adequate to their needs.

Target group

The training course is addressed to primary and secondary school teachers, VET teachers, VET trainers, adults' teachers, managers and employees of enterprises as well as social and youth workers of non-profit organization and public entities.

Course language

This course can be provided both in English and Spanish.

Methodology

The methodology used in the course consists mostly on practical tasks with the teacher's explanation of specific contents related to the objectives of the course.

Constant feedback from the teacher will ensure that the concepts, tools and methods are acquired by all participants.
